



# 2025 WEIS MARKETS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

## Purpose

Celebrating 48 years, Weis Markets, Inc. Scholarship Program provides an opportunity to support undergraduate and graduate Weis Markets' associates and children of Weis Markets' associates who have an interest in furthering their education.

## Awards

Every year, Weis awards up to 40 scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each for up to four years, totaling up to \$10,000 per student. Thirty awards are allocated for high school students graduating in the spring of 2025 and 10 awards are for students with at least two years of undergraduate or graduate school remaining.

## Eligibility

1. Applicants must be an active associate or a child of an active associate in good standing who has been employed with Weis Markets for at least one year as of March 1<sup>st</sup> of the year for which the scholarship will be awarded.
2. Applicants must be a high school student graduating in the spring of 2025 or an undergraduate or graduate student with at least two years remaining by the time of the award and in good standing with Weis Markets every year thereafter while receiving the scholarship. If the applicant is a child of a Weis Markets associate, the associate/parent must be in good standing as well for the student to receive the scholarship each year. Otherwise, the award will be revoked.
3. The parent and/or student must be continuously actively employed with Weis Markets through the recipient selection and announcement process.
4. If the applicant or a child of an active associate worked at Weis Markets in the past, it must be indicated on the application. Otherwise, the application will be considered incomplete.

## Selection Criteria

A committee of admissions officers from local colleges and universities including Bucknell University, Bloomsburg University, Lycoming College, The Penn State University and Susquehanna University will review applications and select the recipients based on the following:

1. Academic standing, GPA, class rank, SAT/ACT scores, and/or College GPA, and number of completed credits
2. Student statement
3. Extra-curricular activities
4. Letter(s) of recommendation

## Application Requirements

To be considered for a Weis Markets Scholarship Award, **all six of the below items must be submitted with your completed application and returned to Weis Markets by March 31, 2025.** The application must include:

1. A completed application form (*only fully completed application forms will be considered with a signature and date*).
2. A one page typed (<300 words) applicant personal statement describing their qualifications and educational/career goals.
3. A completed High School/College Guidance Counselor or School Official Statement Form. *Must be signed and dated.*
4. A one page typed (<300 words) response from the high school/college guidance counselor or school official describing the applicant's academic and character statement to determine why the applicant is worthy of being selected for a scholarship.
5. An official school transcript which includes SAT or ACT scores or a college transcript for the last two years including GPA.
6. A completed Employer Recommendation Form (if the applicant is employed).

Note: Prior versions of the scholarship application will not be accepted

## Submission of Academic and Character Written Statement

The Academic and Character Written Statement should be emailed as a pdf file (with the name of the applicant as part of the file name) directly from the writer to Sandra Kimble at [HR@weismarkets.com](mailto:HR@weismarkets.com). Alternatively, letters can be mailed to the Weis Markets address listed above. The letter should indicate how the letter writer knows the applicant (e.g., as a guidance counselor, principal, or other capacity). **FACSIMILIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Weis Markets Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, national origin, age, disability, marital status, citizenship, genetic information, or any other characteristic protected by law. Weis Markets prohibits any such discrimination.

Recipients will be selected by an independent panel based on academic achievement, overall character, leadership and community involvement. Recipients will be notified in May. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school the recipient will attend each year as long as the transcript is received and the applicant/parent is in good standing.

Applicants agree to accept the independent judging panel's decision as final.
